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Gradual Release of iPads

Students will meet all of OMS success criteria **before** bringing the iPad home.

Gradual release will take approximately **two weeks**.

Success criteria:

- Appropriate Planner Use
- Prepared for class with all required materials
- Notability App set up
- Schoology (Learning Management System) set up

Success criteria will be revisited throughout the year.

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Planner Use

Students at OMS are provided with a School Planner. The Planner has a toolkit, located at the beginning of the planner, for students and parents to reference throughout the year.

Planner Expectations:

- Learning Target written for each class
- The assignment or NO HW written for each class
- Learning Target is highlighted or marked for understanding
- Parent/Guardian signature
- Advisory teacher signature for the first two weeks of school

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Homework Expectations

RAIDER HOUR

Students at OMS are expected to participate in one hour of school work each day (outside of school hours).

Outside of schoolwork includes any of the following:

- View planner for homework and learning targets
- Completing any assignment from class that day
- Reading (at least 20 minutes per day)
- Reviewing your Focused notes from class (highlighting important information, reflecting on the left hand side, or summarizing)
- Study class materials
